Policy statement

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements of the EYFS in ensuring Hopscotch Playgroup is a no-smoking environment - both indoor and outdoor.

Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- Staff who smoke only do so during rest breaks and away from the premises and its grounds.
- Staff who smoke during their break make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues.
- E-cigarettes and all such apparatus is included in this policy and its procedures.
